Subject :change of weapon order

Dear sir,

I shri.... Holder of license no ... valid upto dd/mm/yy, for one .32 bore pistol/revolver number would like to replace this existing weapon with a .45 pistol. Please note I am opting for a change as the present .32 is inadequate for self defence and the model being outdated. Hence I want to opt for a new age 45 pistol.

Please note I want to render the existing 32 pistol/revolver unserviceable as per rule 80(2) of Indian arms rules 2016, please grant me permission to get it unserviceable by an authorised gunsmith, my choice of gunsmith is.... However I can get it done by the gunsmith of your choice.

I have enclosed form B2 as per arms rules 2016, and would request you to grant me permission to render my above mentioned weapon unserviceable as per law and post that I am allowed to purchase a new 45 bore pistol. I hope the application will be processed within the stipulated time of 7days of receipt of application as per schedule V sl 17 of the Indian arms rules 2016.
